Why enroll in Medicaid and/or Healthy Montana Kids?

- The Medicaid program covers 1 in 5 Americans
- Medicaid covers a broad array of health services and limits enrollee out-of-pocket costs, premiums, and cost-sharing.
- Dual IHS and Medicaid coverage offers Tribal Members enhanced access to healthcare services.

Who is eligible for Montana Medicaid?

- Tribal members may be eligible for dual enrollment in IHS and Medicaid. Our staff can help you enroll.
- To be eligible, you must be a resident of the state of Montana, in need of health care/insurance assistance, whose financial situation would be characterized as low income or very low income.

You must have an annual household income (before taxes) that is below the following amounts:

Annual Household Income Limits (before taxes)

Household Size*	Maximum Income Level (Per Year)
1	\$12,880
2	\$17,420
3	\$21,960
4	\$26,500
5	\$31,040
6	\$35,580
7	\$40,120
8	\$44,660

It's important to note that no child will be denied services through One Health due to lack of insurance coverage or inability to pay.

What services are covered under Medicaid?

Medicaid's benefits reflect each individual person's needs. Services covered under Medicaid include pre-natal care and delivery costs for pregnant women, routine and specialized care for childhood development (immunizations, dental, vision, speech therapy), and affordable coverage to prepare for the unexpected (emergency dental, hospitalizations, antibiotics).
